2013 National Arbor Day Poetry Contest

Sponsored by Berkshire Conservation District



About the Contest

In celebration of National Arbor Day on April 26, 2013, Berkshire Conservation District is hosting a poetry contest in Berkshire County for children in grades 4 through 12. The poem theme is "In Praise of Trees" and should be at least 12 lines long but no longer than 1 page typed or hand written. The style and topic of the poem is completely up to the student's choosing but we encourage students to write from their own experience in nature, keeping in mind the set theme.

Contest entries will be due on Arbor Day and winners will be awarded with live tree seedlings to plant either in their schools or homes and three Pocket Nature Guides of their choosing. The purpose of this contest is to engage youth in creatively thinking and learning about trees and nature in celebration of National Arbor Day as well as to promote the planting and care of trees in their community.

Contest Rules

The poem theme is *In Praise of Trees*. Entries should be at least 10 lines long but no longer than 1 page typed or hand written. The style and topic of the poem is completely up to the student's choosing but we encourage students to write from their own experience in nature keeping in mind the chosen theme. Students in grades 4 through 12 may enter. All poems must have a title and include the word "tree" somewhere in the poem. Poems must be the original creation of the student. Students with learning or other disabilities may receive help from an adult in writing and submitting their entry. Entries will be divided into two age groups: grades 4-7 and grades 9-12. Poems will be judged based on:

- 1. Quality of language and writing (30%)
- 2. Creativity and thought put into the work (30%)
- 3. Relevance to the topic and theme of the contest and attention to contest rules (40%)

Entry Instructions

- 1. Fill out a contest entry form and include it with your entry.
- 2. Please write your <u>name</u> and your <u>school grade</u> on the back side of your poem.
- 3. Send entries by **Friday, April 26, 2013** (National Arbor Day) to:
